 - c. The Officer has been permanently absorbed in MTNL.
- 5. These promotions are subject to the outcome of the SLP No.11339/2008 pending in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. In case of unfavourable decision in respect of these Officers, they shall be reverted to their substantive grade without any prior notice.
- 6. Further, in case any direction from Hon'ble Court(s)/CAT for not effecting the promotion to an individual/ individuals, the Officer(s) shall not be promoted to the higher grade by the concerned Units.
- In accordance with the instructions contained in DOT Office Circular No. 12/75/2000-STG.I dated 18/8/2000, the Officers are required to join their promotional assignment within a time period of 40 (forty) days.
