We sincerely believe, MTNL/DOT should nip in the bud such rumour stating unequivocally that no such move is underway even in contemplation. This will help employees to a great extent to be relived of sense of job insecurity and devote whole heartedly in their work.

One thing is certain to be understood by all those whomsoever is concerned that MTNI. employees are basically the Central Govt. employees and they can not be and should not be victimized by removing from the services under any pretext simply because it is stamped as so called "PSU". MTNI employees are not the party to the decline of MTNL. They are putting all efforts to save and secure MTNL service day and night. It is the policy of the successive Governments and a section of top managements who are on DOT's roll, have systematically ruined MTNL as an organization. Our submissions, suggestions and warnings from time to time in this respect remain unheard.

It will be sheer injustice that those who are responsible for decline of MTNL will set scot free and employees who are devoted to MTNL, will subject to victimization. Such move can not go unprotested and without resistance.
