All those aforesaid demands are pending over the years. United Forum and its associated unions and associations repeatedly represented in favour of resolving these issues. But the authority that be, preferred to remain silent over these issues and continued to ignore.

Ultimately we notified PROTEST ACTIONS in form of :

LUNCH HOUR DEMONSTRATION on 08/01/2016 # DAY LONG DHARNA & FAST on 29/01/2016

mainly with a view to calling attention of DOT/MTNL towards these issues for early solution while ensuring that these programmes did not cause to hardship to our customers in any manner.

But most unfortunately, despite massive participation of the employees in this Protest Actions, DOT/MTNL continue to ignore these issues. The indifferent approach of DOT/MTNL is conspicuous by their stark silence over this.

Now what is left for the employees of MTNL? Should they forget their legitimate demands? Or, should they resort to the higher form of trade union actions that may ultimately cause to the adverse impact of the services being provided to the customers?

Even now we earnestly hope, the cautious approach of the employees to sort out the issues amicably would not go unreciprocated on the part of DOT/MTNL.

It is now entirely in the hand of DOT/MTNL to decide whether they will willingly subject the already dwindling services to otherwise avoidable **TRADE UNION ACTIONS** in near future or not.
