Sir,

MTNL Corporate Office has quite rightly decided, even though at much belated stage, to scrap the process of recruitment of **MTNL Senior Management Trainee (E-5 grade)** and has issued the order to that effect vide ref.(1) above.

This Association brought to the notice of the Corporate Management of MTNL various discrepancies and illegalities nakedly practiced by the HR sections vide our letter under ref.(2) above. We stated a number of categorical discrepancies and flouting of rules which, it is difficult to believe, can be done without any corrupt nexus and motive. But even after waiting more than three months, when we did not get any response from the Corporate Management, particularly from HR unit, we sent reminder vide letter under ref (3) reiterating the discrepancies and illegalities. Barely after one month thereafter, MTNL Corporate Office rose to the occasion and scrapped the said process. It is better late than never.

However, the action taken by the Corporate office is still inconclusive and inadequate. Because the next logical action is to identify and fix the responsibility of all those obnoxious elements in the management who are actually responsible for this. MTNL should mercilessly act against these elements, because these are the elements for which MTNL has earned bad reputation.

We hope, MTNL Corporate office should act appropriately and we shall wait for some time to see this, Otherwise this Association will be at liberty to take up the issue with higher appropriate authority.
