<u>Subject</u>:- Deadlock in the preparation and printing of CG PPO Books of combined holders of MTNL and issue of NOC by the O/o the Pr.CCA, New Delhi to the pensioners for getting CGHS cards.

Sir / Madam,

We are seriously worried due to the present deadlock in the work of the preparation and printing of CG PPO Books and prospect of issue NOC to the eligible MTNL pensioners for getting CGHS cards. During last couple of months the progress of the work has hit lowest bottom.

The worst about this is that both the O/o the Pr.CCA/Delhi Region and MTNL appear to be indifferent about this and both the stakeholders are engaged in a sort of mutual "blame game".

The pensioners and some of their organizations have repeatedly pointed out to the concerned officers about this situation. It has been repeatedly told that unless CG PPO Books are issued to the pensioners, they will remain deprived of the benefit of CGHS.

But their repeated pleas fall flat so far. The O/o the Pr.CCA / Delhi Region has even refused to receive required documents from MTNL,Delhi for issue of NOC so that the pensioners who are already in receipt of PPO Books can apply for CGHS cards.

The situation is desperate in view of the fact that the rates of contributions payable by the individual candidates for getting CGHS card is likely to hike sharply and soon. In that situation, there will be a huge additional financial burden on the pensioners. This is definitely avoidable if the concerned units of the O/o the Pr.CCA/Delhi and MTNL take due interest in this matter.

In view of the situation narrated above, we would request you to take urgent steps to arrest the deterioration of the progress. Otherwise the pensioners will suffer irreparable loss.
