

The United Forum pointed out that DOT should keep all action in abeyance relating to creation of Pension Trust till the final outcome in the matter of payment of pension directly by the Govt. as pursuing the former is likely to jeopardize the later.

After protracted discussion between DOT, the management of MTNL and the United Forum, the Forum expected that the management this time should come forward in a way so as to repose the confidence in the workers which has been lost over the period of 12 years since the demand relating to pension has been being raised from time to time.

It is advised that in the interest of smooth and harmonious industrial relations both the parties should continue to engage in bi-partite discussion over all the issues and the United Forum is also advised not to resort to the direct action as proposed not only in view of the commitments expressed by the DOT and the management of MTNL but also of the fact that the matter is seized in conciliation.

Next date shall be fixed in due course after hearing from the management and the United Forum.
